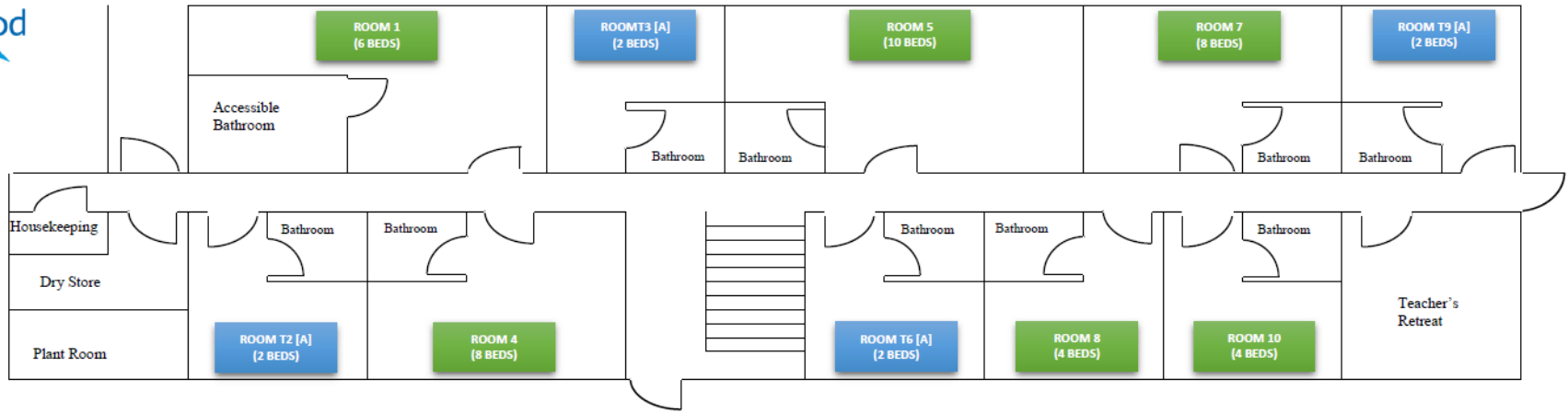
- The children will be sleeping in single sex dormitories of 4, 6, 8 or 10.

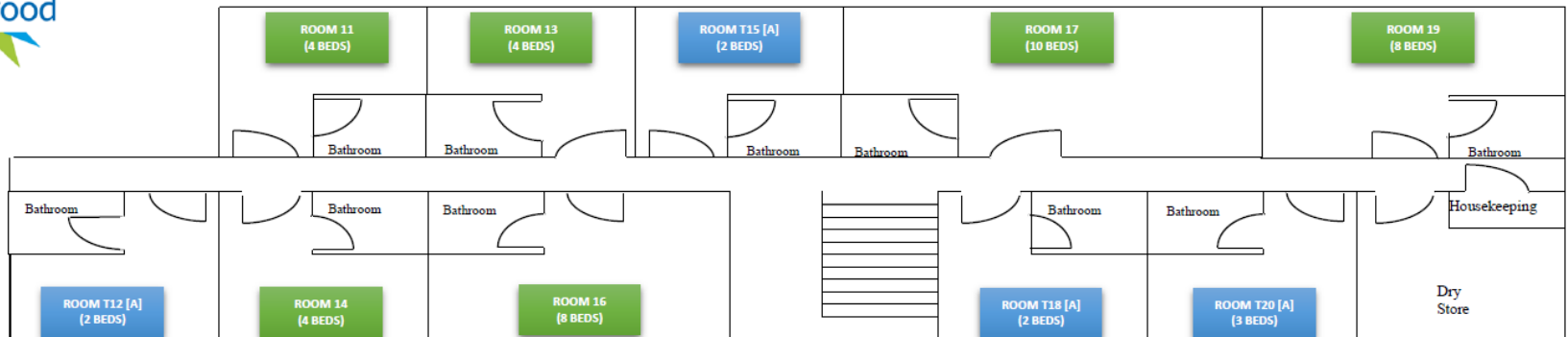
