Quick Parent Guide

What does my child need to bring to school?

Your child needs to come to school in PE uniform: black shorts, plain white t-shirt and black/white trainers. They will also need a sun hat, water bottle and sun cream on them before school.

Can I take photos and videos of my child?

You are allowed to take photos and videos during the Sports Day but we do ask that nothing goes onto social media that has any other children in. This is a safeguarding risk and if parents do not follow this rule, it could change school's decisions in the future. Please also be considerate of each other when taking photos to ensure everyone can see.

Can I be with my child on Sports Day?

We ask that all parents remain in the 'Parent Zone' throughout the Sports Day. There will be chairs provided but you are welcome to bring a camping chair if you would like. If you are needed for any reason a member of staff will come and ask you to join your child. The reason behind this decision is to allow us to safeguard all children and keep them in one location throughout the event. It would really help if you spoke to your child about this before the event as well.

What events are taking place?

There are a variety of races taking place on Sports Day, the children have been practicing within their PE lessons. All children are encouraged to take part in at least 1 race. Your child will know which event they are competing in, so please ask them and listen out for the race starting. At the end of each race, there are stickers awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place and a photo on the OBS podium. After all the children's races, there will be an opportunity for a toddler race and a parent's race (bring your trainers if you want to take part!)

OBS Sports Days are a fun event for both children and parents and we ask for lots of cheers and encouragement for all the children who are taking part. Please respect one another and the OBS staff.
