## Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> April – General Update

### Uniform

As the warmer weather has started to appear (not sure for how long), we have seen an increase in pupils removing coats and jumpers when playing outside. I once again ask that you make sure all items of clothing are named so we can get them back to their owner the same day. Unfortunately, when a child or adult says 'it's a size 26' that does not help, as that is the same as lots of children.

### Water Bottles

**Please can I remind all parents to send their child to school daily with a named water bottle.** We are having an increasing number of pupils asking for plastic cups each day which is not good for the environment. We will of course not let a child go without a drink but it is easier for them to have their own bottle.

### Medicines including inhalers

If your child needs to have prescribed medication in school, please make sure it is handed into the office each day and the relevant medical form is completed.

If your child has an inhaler, please make sure you have updated their 'asthma care plan' and we have a named, in date inhaler in school.

If your child is not feeling 100% but is well enough to come to school but you think they would need paracetamol (Calpol) during the day, **please provide school with this** and complete the medical form at the office.

If your child suffers with hay fever, please make sure they have the correct medication in school or have had it before school each day.

### Parking

I am once again asking that all parents/adults who drop off and collect from school do so in a safe, considerate and legal way. I have received a number of complaints from residents about cars being parked over drives, blocking pavements and in some instances, residents being verbally abused. As a school, we are not allowed to 'police' the public highways so I encourage all parents and residents who have concerns to contact the local community police which is what we do as a school.
