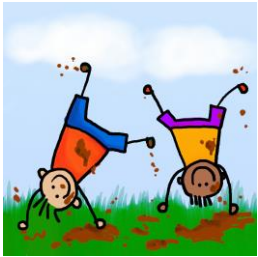


OBS: RBA Risk Benefit Assessment

Activity: Tarpaulin, clips and den making

Benefits:

- We can make lots of wonderful things using the fabrics and clips.
- We can have fun and explore different materials and objects.
- We can be creative.
- We can work collaboratively as a team.
- We can try new things.
- We can take risks in a safe way.



Activity Ideas:

- We might want to make a tent.
- We might want to make a den with our friends.
- We could make a puppet show / theatre.
- We could create games using the fabric.
- We might want to make a pretend camp fire.



Risks:

- We could hurt our bodies or others if we wrap or carry someone using the fabric
- We could find it hard to breathe if wrapped up in fabric
- We would get stuck wrapped up inside the fabric
- We could get pinched or fingers trapped in the pegs and clips
- We could slip and fall if we walk on the fabric
- We could get hurt by others inside the tent / dens

Risk Management:

- We will not use the fabric to carry or swing others around
- We will not wrap the fabric around other children
- We will not throw the pegs / clips
- We will not pinch anyone with the pegs / clips
- We will not use the pegs and clips to put on other people's clothes
- We will not walk on the fabric
- We will not play games like tug of war with the fabric
- We will behave sensibly inside the tents and dens that are made.
