Pupil Premium (PP) and Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) are additional funding available to school and nursery to help us to provide the best possible education and support for your children.

PP is for children in school (years F2 to Year6) and EYPP is for children attending the nursery. Both PP and EYPP are only available to pupils who meet set criteria.

Children in school (years F2 to Year6) who do qualify will be also entitled to Free School Meals when their child is in Years 3-6, a free item of uniform (sweatshirt or cardigan) each year, and reduced charges for school visits. Children new to F2, who qualify for PP, will also receive a free book bag and P.E. bag.

To help us claim for those pupils who are eligible, and so increase the funding for our school and nursery, please take a few minutes to complete the form below.

The information provided will be used by Nottingham City Council to confirm receipt of one of the listed welfare benefits. Please ensure that you sign and date the bottom of the form to consent to these checks.
