Year Three Sleepover

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are planning to have an overnight camp on our school field on **Wednesday 9th July**. The children will go home after school as usual to change and collect their kit. They will then need to arrive back in school at 5.00pm. School will provide pizzas for tea then staff will run activities throughout the evening and will provide a biscuit and a drink before bedtime. The school grounds will be totally secure and there will be a heavy staff presence throughout the night. Staff will be on a rota to oversee the sleeping area throughout the night.

As the following day is a Thursday, we will give the children breakfast and then we have fun activities planned for the morning. For ease, it would probably be better for your child to have a school dinner on Thursday as we will not be able to refrigerate packed lunches (alternatively feel free to drop off their lunch box on the Thursday morning).

There is a £3.50 charge which goes towards pizza, snacks, breakfast and the upkeep of the tents. This should be paid through Arbor by **Friday 27th June**.

We are then giving you permission to collect your child after the afternoon register (1.30pm onwards)

From previous years, we know that this is a great experience for the children. We hope the sleepover will help improve independence in preparation for spending a night away from home during camping trips in Years 4-5.

Kit List:

- Sleeping bag (Local supermarkets sell these, or you may know a family member who has one from previous years)
- Pillow
- Pyjamas (warm)
- Teddy
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Dressing Gown or a warm Hoody
- Slippers
- Medication (if your child requires medication, please speak to the class teacher about this)
- A change of clothes for the following day
