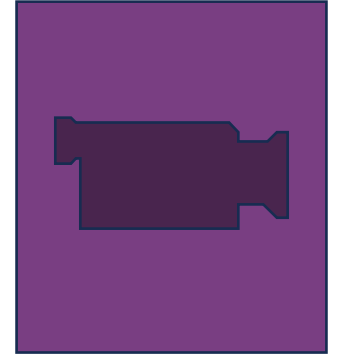
Sacred thread ceremony

Purifying-fresh start

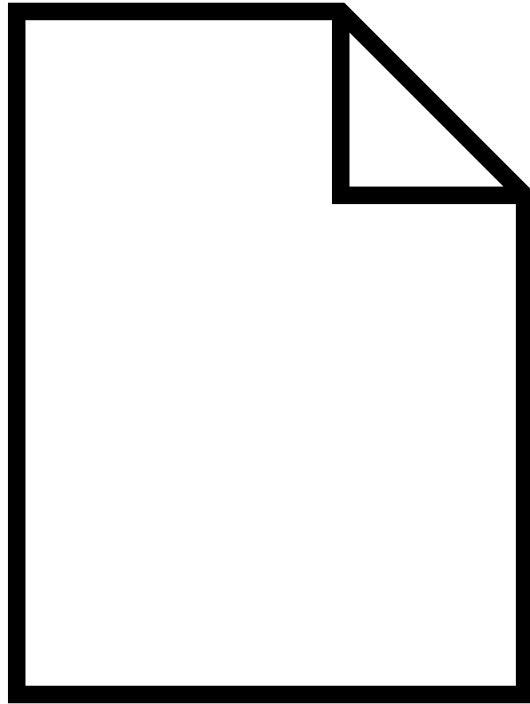
Watch the film- note what happens in this sacred thread ceremony
